BIG VIC raced in the second flight, split horses and was gaining late. LITTLEBROWNROAD broke very slowly and had some late run. JUMP 'IEN swung out seven wide and had a mild rally. JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE vied for the lead inside then dropped back in the turn. NIGHT GENIUS vied for the lead between horses but failed to sustain his bid. PICKNUPBITS showed no early speed and was not a factor. LUCKY MERLOT raced in the second flight off the rail, raced wide and came up empty. Y CHANCE IT saved ground early and did not rally.
