**Footnotes**

MACHO TORO was rated tracking the leaders while switching off the inside in the opening quarter, began a steady advance to contention along the inside leaving the backstretch, shifted out three wide leaving the far turn, took charge in upper stretch and drew clear under firm encouragement. JUNGLE HEART swerved inwards at the start impeding MORE THAN ABLE, took up a tracking position in second flight along the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside midway through the backstretch to advance five deep entering the second bend, continued well outside foes to secure second in late stages but couldn't gain terms with the winner. MORE THAN ABLE, steadied at the break when forced in by JUNGLE HEART, was taken in hand while shifting well off the inside on the first turn, made steady progress to improve his placing racing five deep into upper stretch and continued with interest in that path to gain a share. CHARGING HOME was hustled to the front from the break, dueled for command along the inside into the far turn and weakened in late stages. STAND AND APPLAUD was reserved in hand outside foes in the opening half, continued outside foes to the far turn and made some belated progress. HAWK ON THE HUNT tracked just off the leaders in the opening half, advanced to challenge three deep racing into the far turn, pressed the issue into upper stretch and gave way. FRANK'S TIME tracked the pace unhurried outside foes to the backstretch but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. ESLA MAMBO, reserved off the inside early, never mounted a serious challenge. IZZY GOLDEN angled inwards from the outset to force the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch but gave way abruptly after a half.
