Footnotes

HARBORTON bobbled at the start, was righted to track the leaders from just out of striking distance outside a rival racing into the turn, was roused to challenge three deep between foes racing through the stretch and wrested command in time under firm right handed encouragement. CAMAGIN settled off the second flight well off the inside in the opening stages, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and found her best stride in late stages to close the gap while narrowly prevailing for second. MISS CHLOE H. broke sharply, attended a rival's pace as part of the first flight in the opening quarter, pressed the issue into upper stretch to gain a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker but was collared by the top pair late. ABUELA EMMA, urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened in late stages. CIRCULAR STREET tracked off the first flight near the inside racing into the bend but couldn't produce a closing bid. MARKREE BREEZE was urged to secure a forward placing three deep in the opening quarter, made a brief bid in that path racing into upper stretch but gave way nearing the furlong marker.
