**Footnotes**

SUMMER'S EMPIRE broke outwards bumping OFFICER MCNEAL at the start, was reserved off the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress four deep on the far turn to gain terms with the first flight between foes racing into upper stretch, continued in close quarters while exchanging some contact with ROY L. racing through the stretch and narrowly edged that foe in time under firm encouragement. The latter, bumped at the start, settled near the inside racing in last to the backstretch, shifted out while making steady progress five deep on the far turn, moved to challenge in that path racing into upper stretch while exchanging some contact with the winner and was just outnodded. OFFICER MCNEAL, bumped at the break then forced into the path of ROY L., was settled in the last flight racing to the backstretch, gradually gathered momentum shifting outside foes racing through the far turn, swung six wide entering upper stretch to challenge in tandem with the top pair but couldn't quite match strides with those foes late. GRACIAS DERENZO, on terms with a rival on the pace from the outset, attended that foe's tempo along the rail in the opening half, pressed the issue inside foes racing through the far turn to upper stretch but yielded leaving the furlong marker. GOOD QUESTION, in close attendance to the pace three deep while under some reserve in the opening half, pressed the pace between foes in that path on the far turn to upper stretch but had no final kick. SLEWZOOM, held up in early stages while angling to the inside, tracked off the first flight to the second bend, briefly awaited an opening midway through the far turn, then angled seven wide racing into the stretch while failing to menace further. FULL FLAME shifted off the inside while under light reserve in the opening stages to track just off the first flight, continued near the inside to the second bend but came up empty while racing in close quarters nearing upper stretch. STITCHTWINE went up from the break to force the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, dueled between foes racing into the far turn and gave way abruptly entering upper stretch.
