Footnotes

HANDSOME BRUNO, in close attendance the pace three deep racing into the first turn, continued in that position while under light rating racing to the second bend, moved to press the issue while shifting out a bit entering upper stretch, continued in an extended skirmish for command to late stages and narrowly prevailed in time under energetic handling. CARTOUCHE, prominent near the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin between foes through the backstretch to the far turn, continued to dispute the issue inside the winner past midstretch and just failed to contain that foe's final bid. INSTILL was settled off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, swung five wide racing into upper stretch but made an effort to improve position while gaining a share. PRINCE OF SPEED, caught four wide in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued evenly in that path on the far turn into upper stretch. BLUSHING PREACHER was guided to the rail in early stages while gaining terms with the first flight, pressed the issue inside foes to the far turn and steadily weakened in the drive. BISHOP CASEY tracked the pace three deep between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn but offered no closing bid. SWEETEST RHYTHM tracked the leaders under rating between foes in the second flight for a half and steadily faded racing through the far turn. BROTHERS NICHOLAS tracked the leaders along the rail as part of the second flight in the opening stages but retreated from contention early.
