INSTILL was well placed off the rail, edged to leader in the stretch, dueled late in the lane and dug in determinedly to best STONEHOUSE. STONEHOUSE broke sharply, set the pace, dueled late in the lane and just missed. BATTEN raced second flight, was no match for the top two but got up for a share. WIN ME OVER raced to the rail, made a middle move inside and lacked a late response. CREATIVE FORCE broke slowly, was back early and failed to menace. NAVY WINGS was unhurried early, loomed a threat wide but was not good enough. STUMBLING BLOCK saved ground and was no threat.
