The additional \$25,000 will be divided \$15,000 to the winner, \$5,000 to second, \$2,750 to third, \$1,500 to fourth and \$750 to fifth, providing an Illinois Conceived and Foaled (IB) has finished in an awarded position. HIGH EXPECTATIONS was allowed to settle, split horses then ran down the leader and was up late. MIGHTY RULE was never far back, took the lead between horses in the turn and held the place. HOLY THURSDAY was void of early speed then closed willingly. DISTORTED GROOM stalked the pace and tired inside. CARUSO raced in the second flight, made a middle move five wide in the turn and dropped back. INFECTIOUS SPIRIT was slow early and passed tiring rivals. LIL BRIAN TOO was fractious in the gate and failed to menace. HE'S HOT SAUCE saved ground and was no factor. ROCHESTER CAT set a pressured pace and gave way.
