Footnotes

TACTICS BEST moved to the fore while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside to the second bend and held safe HOMES THE FACT through the final quarter while shifting out late to prevail under firm handling. The latter gained terms with the pacesetter attending that foe's tempo racing to the backstretch, was urged to press the issue on the far turn into upper stretch but proved only second best. BUTTERCUPS BABY was rated along the inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance, shifted out nearing the far turn splitting rivals, switched out three deep in upper stretch and continued willingly to close the gap. CURZON STREET, in close attendance to the pace three deep racing to the backstretch, steadily from contention racing into upper stretch. HIPPODROME settled in last along the inside early and never menaced. PURPLEGREENANDGOLD tracked just off the leaders outside foes racing to the backstretch, shifted to the inside nearing the far turn and faded early.
