### Footnotes

E. GRACE went up from the break to dictate the pace on a narrow margin along the inside, continued with a steady bid into upper stretch and edged clear late under pressure. MIRKA stalked just off the pacesetter along the rail racing into the turn, shifted outside the leader while being urged to challenge that foe in upper stretch but proved only second best. SPECIALAGENTNCHARG settled outside foes in the last flight early, shifted four wide racing into the stretch and made an effort to improve position while earning a share. ROYAL SEVEN settled in last racing off the inside in the opening quarter, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring foes. CHE SERAI was a brief factor tracking just off the first flight while shifting three deep racing into the turn but had no closing bid. NATIVE SWORD joined the pace outside the eventual winner in the opening stages but emptied out after a half.
