Footnotes

APRETTYUNDERSTUDY, prominent four wide in the opening stages while gaining terms with the first flight, shifted inwards nearing the turn while moving to force the issue outside a rival, continued with a steady bid to wrest command racing into upper stretch while shifting to the rail and drew clear under firm handling. ANNIE'S SHOWTIME, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival in the opening stages, dueled along the rail racing into the turn but proved no match in late stages. GOSTOSA, in touch with the first flight along the inside in early stages, tracked the leaders along the inside on the turn, shifted out racing into upper stretch while being urged to advance but finished evenly late. SECRET VIOLET stumbled at the break bumping AULT STREET, was guided outside foes to gain some position racing four wide into the turn, was fanned six wide into the stretch and continued with an effort to gain some position while making no real impression. BACARELLA tracked the leaders out of striking distance three deep between foes racing to the turn and offered no closing bid. DRAGONFLY CHASER settled into stride along the inside in the opening quarter and never seriously menaced. AULT STREET, bumped at the start, settled in the last flight outside a rival and never mounted a serious challenge. SWEET STORMY was a brief factor three deep between foes chasing the pace but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
