Footnotes

RENO RIDGE was urged to secure terms with a rival on the lead racing along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside, then turned back a challenge from COSTILLA RANGE leaving the furlong marker to prevail in a prolonged drive. The latter broke sharply, attended a rival's pace under light rating racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner in the final eighth. DOUG JUNIOR stalked just off and outside the first flight under rating in the opening half, moved to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but had no final kick. IMAGE OF GRANDEUR tracked the leaders in second flight outside a rival under some reserve, angled out four wide nearing upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. MING GLO, held up along the inside racing as part of the second flight, made a brief bid entering the far turn but quickly flattened out. STAR RATING, climbing a bit in early stages, switched outside foes racing through the first turn but never gained contention.
