Footnotes

THIEF, urged to join the pace from between foes after the opening sixteenth, forced the pace outside a rival entering the bend, edged forward to a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker and drew clear late under brisk right handed prompting. HATFIELD broke sharply to gain a clear lead in the opening sixteenth, relinquished the lead to several foes after the opening quarter to stalk those foes racing into the bend, commenced a steady bid three deep nearing upper stretch, couldn't regain terms with the winner but narrowly prevailed for place honors racing four deep between foes. SARATOGA SEVEN tracked the leaders unhurried outside foes in the last flight early, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch while producing a steady response, then continued in that path to late stages while just missing for second. COUNTY CLERK settled out of striking distance while angling to the inside, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted off the inside to split foes near midstretch and continued with a mild bid. CERTIFIED COPY was urged to gain a forward placing inside foes after the opening sixteenth, moved to challenge for the lead after the opening furlong, duelled for command into upper stretch but steadily faded in late stages. CRYPTO GULCH, urged along four deep chasing the leaders into the turn, was spent after a half.
