Footnotes

MARITIME MAN, within striking distance between foes in the opening stages, stalked the first flight between foes under light rating racing into the bend, shifted out to challenge three deep entering upper stretch and made steady progress to the end to just edge ARCTIC POINT in the final strides under firm handling. The latter joined the pace outside a rival soon after the start, pressed the issue into upper stretch to gain a narrow advantage nearing the furlong marker, resisted the winner to the end and just failed to contain that foe. OLD LOW DOWN tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight racing into the bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. TETON MOTEL sprinted to the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. SHELLBARK was settled outside a rival from out of striking distance early and never gained contention. GRAN TORINE, held up outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. IN ALL DIRECTIONS broke awkwardly losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter.
