Footnotes

TURN N' FIRE, reserved off the second flight while switching off the inside in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention while shifting out four wide racing into upper stretch and responded to firm handling to just edge LALO'S BABY BEAR in time. The latter gained terms with the first flight three deep between foes in the opening stages attending the pace, pressed the issue between foes into upper stretch, edged forward to a clear advantage nearing the furlong marker, gamely resisted the winner to the end but just failed to fend off that foe. JIMMY GOT EVEN was held up just off the first flight tracking the leaders outside a rival racing to the turn, split foes near the inside racing into upper stretch to gain some position but couldn't match terms with the top two. BANK ACCOUNT, prominent four wide in the opening stages, pressed the pace three deep on the turn to upper stretch and gave way. SPIKEY ITALIANO broke readily to dictate the pace between foes on a narrow margin, shifted to the inside after the opening furlong disputing the lead into the bend, dueled into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. WILDWOOD HEIR, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, was eased off the first flight to track those foes along the rail into the bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
