HIGH EXPECTATIONS was squeezed back at the start and showed no early speed and settled well, angled out at the top of the stretch and closed with a rush to get up in time. DISTORTED GROOM raced close up and moved while five wide, led late but was only second best. SUB FUTZ JR rated well between horses early, battled in the stretch and was outfinished while inside. OUT FOR A SPIN raced in the second flight and made a mild rally late. LAST GRAN STANDING was rushed to the lead and gave way after a half. STORMY O' BRYAN stumbled at the start and raced in the middle of the pack and was no factor. ROCHESTER CAT was rushed to contention and stopped. BARELY UNION SCALE showed no speed and was no threat.
