Footnotes

HUNGRY WILDCAT was settled out of striking distance while being guided to the inside in the opening stages racing well off the second flight, saved ground entering the far turn while steadily drawing into contention inside foes, shifted out to split foes near the inside entering upper stretch to challenge and was roused clear. GO DOUG GO tracked off the second flight along the inside under rating in the opening half, made a steady advance to contention along the rail entering the second bend, moved to challenge inside foes nearing upper stretch but was outkicked by the winner. SICOMORO, held up just off the first flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out to split foes midway through the far turn, angled five wide entering upper stretch while being urged to challenge but couldn't match strides with the top pair late. DENIM tracked off the second flight four wide racing to the backstretch, continued in that

path into the second bend while making steady progress, was fanned six wide in the stretch but continued willingly to the end. PAISANO CREEK was settled off the last flight for five furlongs, saved ground into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position inside foes late. STANLEY G. tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing to the second bend, continued in that path while caught in tight quarters midway through the second bend and lacked the needed final kick. TURNPIKE TOMMY, reserved between foes off the second flight in the opening half, was caught in tight quarters while being prompted to advance racing through the far turn and lacked the needed final response. PART'N PARCEL was urged to the lead near the inside racing into the first turn, dueled for command on the far turn to upper stretch and emptied out. GO PATRICK GO, reserved outside foes well off the second flight early, was caught five wide racing into the far turn and lacked a closing response. UNDER LIKE THUNDER joined the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, pressed the issue between foes into the second bend and emptied out nearing upper stretch. PRESENTS FOR BERTI was urged to a forward placing four wide in the opening stages, stalked just off the first flight three deep into the second bend, was steadied in traffic in that path racing through the far turn and steadily retreated after six furlongs. IKAROS trailed throughout. DUE TO A TELETIMER MALFUNCTION, INTERNAL SPLITS WERE NOT AVAILABLE.
