GATO'S PIRATE was urged to join the pace inside a rival after the opening sixteenth, disputed the issue into upper stretch, then responded to firm right handed pressure to turn back the challenge of JUMP 'IEN in the final furlong to prove best The latter tracked the leaders unhurried off the second flight racing four wide on the backstretch, advanced to striking position in that path racing through the turn, loomed outside the winner nearing midstretch but couldn't quite match terms with that foe in the last furlong. GRAND COMPOSER, slow into stride, shifted to the inside dropping off the second flight early, shifted out leaving the turn to advance five wide between foes, was bumped by ESLA MAMBO racing through the stretch but continued with interest to close the gap while prevailing for a share. ESLA MAMBO was settled off the second flight three deep between foes in the opening stages, shifted out leaving the turn, was fanned six wide in upper stretch, drifted inwards bumping GRAND COMPOSER racing through the stretch while continuing willingly and was just outkicked for a share. ASHEN LORD broke sharply, forced the pace outside a rival racing into the bend and gave way nearing midstretch when proving no match. ONE FOR BISCUIT tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, shifted to the inside nearing upper stretch and gave way. CREOLE'S AFFAIR was held up just off the second flight between foes near the inside racing into the bend but offered no closing bid. AUTO KING tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. DISTORTED GROOM, urged to secure a position three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, made a brief bid between foes in that path midway through the turn but emptied out abruptly after a half.
