FOR FOUR-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. ILLINOIS REGISTERED CONCEIVED AND/OR FOALED. By subscription of \$75 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$750 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start. With \$100,000 added, plus an additional \$25,000 for Illinois Conceived and Foaled (IB). The \$100,000 added purse shall be divided with 60 percent, 20 percent to second, 11 percent to third, 6 percent to fourth and 3 percent to fifth. The additional \$25,000 will be divided \$15,000 to the winner, \$5,000 to second, \$2,750 to third, \$1,500 to fourth and \$750 to fifth, providing an Illinois Conceived and Foaled (IB) has finished in an awarded position. WEIGHTS SUNDAY, APRIL 22, 2012. NOTE: This stake will be limited to fourteen starters. High weights (including sex allowance) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights, and second weighted parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. Failure to draw into race will cancel all fees with the exception of nomination fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A trophy will be awarded to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, April 18, 2012 with 13. (S)

RIVER BEAR was settled into stride a bit off the inside racing off the second flight in the opening quarter, steadily gathered momentum on his courage while shifting out four wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response in that path to gain command from between foes in the final sixteenth while his rider maintained his attention flashing a right handed whip. SIGNSEALNDELIVER tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight from out of striking distance racing into the turn, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch and continued with interest to prove best of the others. STATIC KILL tracked the leaders along the inside as part of the second flight racing into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch while gaining some position inside foes but was outkicked by the top pair. FOUR LEFT FEET settled well off the field racing into the bend, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress in that path. SACRED GIFT, reserved outside foes well off the second flight early, angled inwards on the turn, then shifted out in upper stretch while making an effort to improve his position between foes. CATFEINATED tracked the leaders four deep in the second flight early, was forced wide racing into the turn avoiding a stricken rival, continued outside foes to upper stretch and offered no rally. LUCK WITH A KISS angled inwards gaining a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter, moved to press the issue between foes nearing midstretch but emptied out in the final sixteenth. CAPT. BULLET BOB moved to the fore while shifting to the inside, set the pace into upper stretch but faltered in the final sixteenth. BIG REWARD tracked

the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the end but emptied out entering upper stretch. BOWMAN'S SECRET briefly contended just off the first flight, was guided to the outside while being pulled up entering the turn, then was vanned off the course.
