FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. ILLINOIS REGISTERED CONCEIVED AND/OR FOALD. By subscription of \$75 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$750 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start. With \$100,000 added, plus an additional \$25,000 for Illinois Conceived and Foaled (IB). The \$100,000 added purse shall be divided with 60 percent to the winner, 20 percent to second, 11 percent to third, 6 percent to fourth and 3 percent to fifth. The additional \$25,000 will be divided \$15,000 to the winner, \$5,000 to second, \$2,750 to third, \$1,500 to fourth and \$750 to fifth, provided an Illinois Conceived and Foaled (IB) has finished in an awarded position. WEIGHTS SUNDAY, APRIL 22, 2012. NOTE: This stake will be limited to fourteen starters. High weights (including scale of weights and sex allowance) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights, and second weighted parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. Failure to draw into race will cancel all fees with the exception of nomination fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A trophy will be awarded to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, April 18, 2012 with 18. (S)

P D Q KIDDO was prompted from the outset to secure a forward placing between foes, shifted to the inside on the first turn to track just off the pacesetter while maintaining striking distance, was urged to challenge inside that foe nearing upper stretch, then produced a steady late response to edge forward late under firm handling. HOPE FOR TODAY was urged to the fore inside foes racing into the first turn, set the pace on a clear margin a bit off the rail racing into the second bend, resisted the winner's challenge to midstretch but couldn't contain that foe. BIG LOOIE, forwardly placed three deep racing into the first turn, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival as part of the second flight for six furlongs, was urged to challenge three deep between foes nearing upper stretch, couldn't maintain terms with the top pair but continued with interest to edge a rival for a share in late stages. COLOR ME BLUE was settled outside foes just off the second flight four deep in the opening stages, continued three deep off the second flight racing though the backstretch while gaining some position, swung out five wide midway through the far turn while being prompted to advance, continued in that path to upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. DENHAM was held up just off the second flight while shifting in early, switched out on the backstretch to race just off the second flight, was urged

to make a brief bid four deep between foes racing through the far turn and steadily faded in the drive. TAPILU settled outside a rival well off the second flight in the opening stages, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch to gain some position but made no impression on the leaders. TABLE GAMES was settled into stride along the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside a tiring foe nearing upper stretch, then continued evenly between foes in the lane while lacking a closing response. BOWMANS CASTLE broke a bit awkwardly, settled in last racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. KNIGHT AFTER NIGHT angled inwards to track the leaders between foes behind the second flight racing into the backstretch, shifted to the inside on the far turn and steadily retreated racing through the stretch. RACING BRAN was rated off the second flight along the rail in the opening half but steadily faded racing into the far turn.
