Footnotes

REBA'S FANCY, within striking distance three deep between foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail approaching the bend to track just off the first flight, came through to bid inside those foes when presented an opening in upper stretch, then wrested command and edged clear under right handed encouragement. MIDNIGHT LACE shifted to the inside gaining a position in the second flight, was held up off the eventual winner when losing her path to that foe momentarily midway through the backstretch, continued along the inside into the bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for second. N'EST CE PAS, reserved off the second flight along the inside, made steady progress along the rail racing into upper stretch and was just outfinished for second. RAJULIE, bumped at the start, settled into stride along the inside, angled five wide racing into the stretch and made mild progress in that path. BUSTED DREAMS broke inwards bumping RAJULIE, was righted to track between foes off the second flight but made an effort to improve position between foes late. WILDCAT DEVIL tracked the pace three deep between foes off the second flight racing into the turn and offered no closing bid. PICKLE SPRINGS was urged to the lead while shifting a bit off the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and faltered late. SENORITA CATRINA settled three deep between foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. STELLAR PRIZE briefly contended four wide between foes

in the opening stages but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. OFF THE LEASH, forwardly placed five deep in the opening stages, shifted in nearing the turn forcing the pace outside a rival and came up empty late. WAPANUCKA hopped at the start, bore out racing into the turn and never menaced.
