DISQUEADA (ARG) raced close up inside, came out three wide for the drive, rallied in the stretch and prevailed at the wire. MS GODA stalked the pace just outside and rallied in the stretch but could not hold off the winner. CLASSIC GARBO lacked speed inside and rallied belatedly through traffic. RACING A PLENTY set the pace from the inside but could not last. MS. MONROE saved ground near the middle of the field and lacked a rally. GO WENT GONE lacked speed and improved her position. POLAR BABY was never a factor. ISBELL AMBIEL showed little. NOT IMPOSSIBLE raced close up off the rail and tired. PUT IT ON was always outrun. FAMILY COVENANT gave way in the drive. STARMINDED was never close.
