MISTY GINA set the pace from the inside while pressed then drew clear in the stretch. CURIOUS CONUNDRUM pressed the pace from just outside but was no match for the winner in the drive. SEAQUIN lacked speed just outside, came four wide into the stretch and rallied for a share but could not make up any ground late. RED WILDCAT saved ground but lacked a serious bid. SWEETEST STAR saved ground but was never a factor. MARY E raced close up just outside and tired. ST. CHAPELLE was always outrun. FLIPS LAST PARTY was never close. MARSHAMARSHAMARSHA was fractious in the gate and was through early.
