CARRENA ROSE raced close up just outside and challenged in the stretch but could not finish with the winner. GERRI'S AUTO BEE set the pace from the inside while pressed and held on well. DIXIE BAY lacked speed inside and rallied belatedly. AESTHETE APPROVAL raced close up off the rail and rallied belatedly. GAME PLAY was never a factor. MATTINA lacked speed and never reached contention. DEHERE OF THE DOG raced close up and dropped back steadily. MOCHA MISS was always outrun. OVERSERVED broke down in the stretch.
