SMALLCLAPOFTHUNDER raced near the middle of the field, split horses entering the stretch and rallied for the place while no match for the winner. LAZY SAHANA lacked speed, came out four wide entering the stretch and rallied but was no match for the winner and lost the place late. BECKISS lacked speed then improved his position in the drive. PHYLLIS COURT hesitated at the start to be away slowly and was not a factor. FIVEOUTOFSIX raced close up off the rail and tired. BECKY'S DESIRE set the pace inside and tired. I CAN GO GO gave way in the drive. MS. MONROE raced close up and was through early. YODAR trailed throughout and was eased in the stretch.
