The latter bore out on the first turn, lacked speed, bore out a bit on the second turn, rallied to challenge in the stretch then could not finish with the top one. STARMINDED rallied belatedly for a share. JUNE IN GREEN BAY made a bid to challenge on the second turn but faltered in the drive. IRISH CONCERN, reluctant to load, lacked a rally. FOR THE MUSIC set the pace while pressed and tired. MERELY THE BEST was not a factor. STARR MIS tired. MELISSA'S ROSE was outrun. ONE WAY OR ANOTHER pressed the pace and gave way.
