RAY'S APPROVAL, hustled to the front, set the pace on an open lead and showed courage in the drive to prevail. STAY SOUND lacked speed, moved up inside in the stretch, angled out for room and finished fastest of all but missed. INKATHA (FR) saved ground from the start, had to wait for room on the second turn, came out to challenge when clear but could not get past the winner and lost the place on the wire. SKY COLONY came off the inside to start his rally, challenged in the stretch but lacked a winning late response. MIDWAY MAGISTRATE was not a factor. RICHTER SCALE raced close up early but tired. FORT METFIELD stalked the pace and tired. ALEA IACTA EST and DA BULL were always outrun.
