SWEARINGEN was allowed to settle, rallied four wide on the second turn, continued gaining in the stretch and was up in the final strides. MY OWN LOVELY LEE saved ground while stalking the leaders, came out to get the lead between calls in deep stretch and just failed to last over the winner. SWING TO THE BEAT rallied belatedly for a share. RUNAWAY EMILY A also had some late speed. HAWAIIAN DANCER pressed the pace, took over in the stretch and faltered. BARN SWALLOW was not a factor. FOUNTAIN SQUARE showed little. SEQUENTIALLY was outrun. EXCISE set the pace while pressed and tired. ARCTICA, four wide on the first turn, raced forwardly, drifted out entering the stretch and tired.
