FROSTY LADY LOVE raced five wide on the turn and rallied belatedly. THIRD ROCK raced close up and put a head in front in the stretch but could not last. RAZAWAN made a bid on the turn but faltered in the final furlong. EMYVALE set the pace on a clear lead but weakened. BALTIC CANDY stalked the pace and tired. CODE FROM HEAVEN raced close up to the stretch and tired. CRESENT DREAMS was outrun. SPEED ON HOLME was through early. LACE EMBRACE gave way in the drive.
