STAKES Hawthorne Gold Cup H. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination. A supplementary nomination of \$10,000 may be made on Saturday, September 22, 2007, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$2,500 additional to start, with \$500,000 guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all starters finishing sixth through last, 60 percent of the remaining purse shall be paid to the winner, 20 percent to second, 11 percent to third, 6 percent to fourth and 3 percent to fifth. A trophy will be awarded to the winning owner. WEIGHTS, SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 2007. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to fourteen starters. High weights (including scale of weights and sex allowance) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights, and second weighted parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. Failure to draw into race will cancel all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations closed Wednesday, September 19, 2007 with 21.

STUDENT COUNCIL stalked the pace while off the rail, headed the leader at the top of the stretch while four wide and was set down for a long drive then drew clear late, finishing very strong. JONESBORO got away alertly and set an easy, early pace, lead to the stretch and was headed at the top of the stretch but set down for the long driving, giving in late posting an overall game effort. A. P. ARROW was taken off the rail early in the race, dropped back to last in the second turn, was hard ridden through the stretch and hit his best stride too late between horses. MIAMI SUNRISE was steadied briefly inside then settled to race mid-pack, angled out turning into the stretch and made a strong bid while five wide to challenge then flattened out in the final sixteenth. WAYZATA BAY dropped in to save ground through both turns, made a bid along the rail at the top of the stretch but came up empty.
