LUCKY MERLOT outpaced while three wide, moved four wide into the stretch, responded to brisk pressure and was up late. DREAM SMART stalked the pace while three wide, continued three wide into the stretch and stayed on. POWERFUL PEPPER was hesitant at the break, outrun early, swung six wide into the stretch and produced a mild bid. TRADEUP chased the pace while four wide, tried to bear out several times, was checked entering the backstretch and offered no bid in the stretch. YUKON JAACK chased the pace while racing along the inside, angled three wide for the stretch run and lacked a rally. EL INTOCHABLE seized command at once, was headed around the far turn and yielded. MOLANDER never menaced. IRISH RUFFIAN was always outrun.
