DELICATESSA raced off the rail near the middle of the field and rallied for the place while no danger to the winner. GOLDEN TREVALLY raced close up inside, dropped back, came seven wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. ONE FINE SHWEETIE raced close up inside and lacked a rally. CHILLING EFFECT lacked speed and improved her position. DREW AWAY was never a factor. ARSEN ANNIE set the pace from the inside and tired. MYMICH gave way in the drive. OF LEGAL AGE had early speed and tired. BE FACTUAL bore out on the first turn and pulled up.
