ICANDAZZLE brushed at the start, saved ground, angled three wide into the stretch and rallied. HAIL VICTORY bumped soundly at the start, entered the stretch three wide and closed ground rapidly through traffic. WHY BE QUIET raced in striking position while four wide, remained four wide into the stretch and stayed on. STARS OF THE SEA settled well, moved five wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. STEALTH displayed mild late interest. CHIEF WHAT never menaced. HANGOVER CURE was void of speed. NIGHT GENIUS stalked the pace and weakened. HANWAY slammed at the start and failed to recover. JOY FROM PHOENIX was outpaced while eight wide and never a factor. BOLD DAYS veered out at the start, gained the early lead, was headed on the turn and gave way.
