Footnotes

TAZZ angled to the inside in the opening stages, tracked off the second flight outside a rival to the far turn, angled in nearing upper stretch, made steady progress inside foes to gain striking distance in late stages, shifted outside the pacesetter in late stages, took over and went clear under pressure. DRIVINGMAXANDMITZI tracked off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out in upper stretch to bid four wide but was outkicked. HARLEQUIN SKY tracked off the leaders along the inside under some reserve into the backstretch, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch to bid between foes but had no final kick. CARSON'S HONOR was urged to the lead along the inside, held sway on a clear margin into upper stretch but faltered late. MR. MISCHIEF tracked the leaders off the second flight while caught four wide early, made a brief bid in that path on the far turn but soon flattened out. RULER OF THE

COURT, carried out in the opening stages while caught between foes in second flight, tracked the pacesetter between foes into the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the pacesetter and emptied out late. WEGGIE settled near the inside in the opening half and passed some tiring rivals racing into the lane. APPROVEDBYTHEMINT never seriously menaced. BIG AL proved no factor. DEVIL ME NOT was settled along the inside but never mounted a serious challenge. PULLMANITE was carried out in the opening stages, continued in the second flight tracking the pacesetter three deep to the far turn, made a brief bid in that path and emptied out. I'VE GOT A SECRET shifted out into the path of several rivals in early stages and steadily faded after a half.
