STAKES Robert F. Carey Memorial H. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination. A supplementary nomination of \$2,000 may be made on Saturday, September 25, 2010, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all starters finishing sixth through last, 60 percent of the remaining purse shall be paid to the winner, 20 percent to second, 11 percent to third, 6 percent to fourth and 3 percent to fifth. A trophy will be awarded to the winning owner. WEIGHTS, SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2010. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to twelve starters. High weights (including scale of weights and sex allowance) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights, and second weighted parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. Failure to draw into race will cancel all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations closed Wednesday, September 22, 2010 with 27. (Rail at 10 feet).

Footnotes

AMAZING RESULTS, reserved outside out a rival in the last flight in the opening half, gathered momentum on the far turn while shifting outside foes, swung five wide in upper stretch, then produced a sustained response to edge TYBALT in the final strides under firm handling. The latter, reserved in hand off the second flight just off the inside in the opening half, shifted out three deep making steady progress on the far turn, moved to challenge the leader four wide among foes in upper stretch, gained the place in late stages but was outkicked by the winner. EXCHANGING KISSES was urged to secure the lead while angling to the rail early, dictated the pace in hand to the backstretch, held sway on a clear margin into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the final furlong. TAWAARED, forwardly placed from the outset, tracked just off the pacesetter under some reserve in the opening half, chased the leader into upper stretch but weakened late when failing to gain term with that foe. MY SONNY BOY, reserved saving ground to the backstretch, shifted outside a tiring foe on the far turn, then split foes near the inside in upper stretch while improving his placing to the end. VANQUISHER tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight for five furlongs and came up empty racing through the far turn. QUITE A HANDFUL, held up between foes near the inside in the opening stages, never gained contention. CABERNEIGH tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside from out of striking distance early, shifted out to make a brief, three wide bid between foes on the far turn but steadily faded in the last quarter. WISE RIVER tracked the pace in second flight along the inside, dropped out of contention entering the far turn, was soon outdistanced and was vanned off after the race.
