Footnotes

SILKY SAMI raced unhurried outside foes in the opening stages dropping out of striking distance early, commenced a steady, three wide advance racing through the turn, shifted out to bid four wide between foes nearing the furlong marker, then wrested command and drew clear late under firm right handed encouragement. UPTOWN BABE settled off the pace early, swung five wide racing into upper stretch while bidding for command in tandem with the winner and couldn't quite match terms with that foe while proving best of the others. NAUGHTY AND NICE went up to prompt the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed the leader racing into upper stretch, couldn't fend off the top pair but continued well enough to prevail for a share. DE LICA, held up from just out of striking distance outside foes racing to the turn, made solid progress on the bend to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. OUR GIRL MAGIC worked her way to the inside tracking the pace from out of striking distance, saved ground to upper stretch and passed inside tiring rivals. STIVERS SUPRISE angled to the inside tracking just off the leaders racing to the bend but was through after a half. GRETA'S RAP moved to the fore to dictate the pace a narrow margin just off the inside, dueled along the rail on the turn and gave way in upper stretch.
