Z'BULLSEYE set a pressured pace, lost the lead in the stretch then gamely came again. OUR CAT found his best stride too late and was gaining between horses. MANEKE lacked room in the turn and had a late rally inside. RAPID RAJ was never far back,had a brief lead in the stretch and weakened in the last strides. AMERICAN RACER was slow early and rallied widest too late. QUIETLY QUICK was void of early speed then rallied between horses. MARTINS POINT was slow early and failed to menace. BOLD DAYS stalked the pace then faltered between horses late. DIAMOND ACCOUNT had good early speed and flattened out.
