Footnotes

RUGGED, in touch with the leaders three deep in the opening stages, stalked those foes in that path racing into the bend, but continued with a steady bid to challenge in that path nearing midstretch and just prevailed in the closing stages under firm handling. HOTPEPPER PLEASE was urged to dispute the pace between foes racing into the bend, pressed the issue outside a rival to upper stretch to and just failed to contain the winner. FROSTBITE FALLS was urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset to upper stretch and weakened a bit in late stages. MEDALQUEST, a bit slow to gather stride, swung outside foes racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. IOLANDA'S PERFECT angled inwards tracking off the first flight racing into the bend and continued evenly between rivals to late stages. I'M OLD SCHOOL was a brief factor outside foes in the second flight but steadily faded nearing the lane. CHEVRONS chased the leaders four wide to the turn but gave way early.
