SPARKLING SABIA raced off the rail and moved up on the turn but was no match for the winner in the drive. PASS THE PEPPER stumbled at the start then set the pace from the inside but could not last. PIANO TUNNER lacked speed three wide and never reached contention. MISS OUTRAGEOUS lacked speed and made a three wide bid on the turn but faltered. CROW JANE was through early.
