WILLIE BAGS broke sharply, stalked the pace comfortably, responded, forged clear into the stretch and held sway late. GREY MONARCHY reserved while six wide, moved five wide into the stretch and rallied under stout left-handed pressure. BABAMOON checked hard leaving the first turn, entered the stretch four wide, kept on but was outfinished. BIG SMOOTH settled behind the pacesetters, raced evenly and lacked the needed kick in the stretch. SCRIMPY outrun early, moved five wide into the stretch and stayed on. ABETTER RETURN was outpaced while five wide and gave no response. TOCCET ROCKET was void of speed and flashed mild late interest. TRUE BEE set a contested pace, was headed leaving the far turn and gave way thereafter. WEGGIE was steadied leaving the first turn and retreated. SAARBRIGHT failed to menace.
