GOALTOGOAL set a contested pace, edged clear into the stretch and maintained his advantage to the wire. MAJESTIC SPIRIT vied for the lead between rivals, moved out five wide into the stretch and stayed on. CLIENT DRIVEN was outpaced in traffic, entered the stretch three wide and flashed late energy. DRINKS TO GO prompted the pace and weakened. BETTER MAKE MONEY reserved early, swung six wide in the stretch and lodged a mild bid. A QUESTION OF TIME chased evenly. GREASY KID STUFF never menaced. RAILSPLITTER was off slowly and failed to recover. SEQUOYAH leaned out at the start brushing PAT'S MAGIC, was urged on the turn and faded in the stretch. The latter brushed at the start, made a bid around the turn and faltered. ECTON ROAD saved ground and offered no bid.
