Footnotes

COURTLY, bumped just after the start, was reserved from striking distance off the inside racing to the backstretch, split foes three wide while being roused to contention entering the far turn, then continued in that path while producing a sustained response to wrest command from DEAL OF A LIFETIME in time under firm left handed encouragement. The latter moved to the fore along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, edged clear racing through upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. ENEMY FIRE, caught five wide early while being prompted to join the pace outside foes, pressed the pace outside a rival racing through the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. BUCKET BOY, bumped at the start, settled along the inside in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn to split foes four wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. THIRD RAIL, bumped soundly at the start, was caught wide racing to the backstretch, continued four, then five wide on the far turn while being prompted to advance and finished evenly racing through the stretch. A FLASH OF GENIUS tracked just off the leaders racing to the far turn, then steadily faded between foes nearing upper stretch. SPOTTED DYLAN shied inwards bumping the winner just after the start, was reserved between foes off the inside racing to the backstretch but never gained striking distance. R T'S BLACK CAT tracked the pace along the rail from just off the second flight in the opening half but steadily faded racing through the far turn. CHOCTAW SMOKE shifted off the inside early racing unhurried off the second flight, was caught four wide racing into the far turn and steadily faded. GET READY HATERS broke inwards bumping BUCKET BOY, was settled

into stride between foes but never menaced thereafter. DEPUTY DALE broke inwards bumping THIRD RAIL soundly, was urged between rivals to gain terms with the first flight racing to the backstretch but was spent early. JET E LEE BOYYY was a brief factor four wide racing just off the first flight in the opening stages but was through after a half.
