**Footnotes**

LIVE FROM APPOLLO hopped at the start, took up a position four deep tracking off the second flight racing to the bend, made a steady advance in that path on the turn to gain striking distance entering upper stretch and continued with a steady response to wrest command in time under firm handling. YANKEE INJUNUITY was reserved out of striking distance along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out advancing through close quarters racing through the stretch and was making solid progress late while prevailing for place honors. HOLD THAT BROAD, forwardly placed near the inside, tracked the pacesetter within striking distance racing into the turn, shifted outside that foe to challenge nearing upper stretch, bid between foes for command leaving midstretch and was outkicked by the top pair. HOODWINKED, reserved off the inside racing to the turn, angled out six wide entering upper stretch and made mild progress in that path to the end. SPEIGHT THE HALO sped to the lead outside foes in the opening stages, held sway on his own courage into upper stretch, was roused to maintain his advantage but faltered in late stages. ALL TANKED UP tracked the leaders three deep between foes in the second flight racing into the bend and continued evenly to late stages. WEKIVA WACHEE, bumped at the start, was settled along the inside racing into the turn, shifted out in upper stretch while being roused to advance, then lost his momentum when losing his path nearing midstretch but continued to improve his position to the end. BIG LOOIE tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight racing to the turn but never gained contention. TELLME ALL ABOUTIT broke outwards bumping WEKIVA WACHEE, was righted quickly to gain a position in the second flight along the inside tracking the leaders under light rating but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. ROYAL EXPRESS, unhurried along the inside early, shifted off the rail nearing the turn to gain a position between foes in the second flight but came up empty midway through the bend. FIRST TRUMPET tracked just off the leaders outside a rival racing to the turn but emptied out abruptly entering upper stretch.
