TRANSPLENDENT, threw his head at the start losing position to the field, settled into stride racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance outside foes nearing the far turn, shifted out entering upper stretch to challenge five wide and wrested a narrow advantage in time under firm encouragement. PAPER MAKER, reserved just out of striking distance tracking the leaders in the opening stages, shifted out on the backstretch, made steady progress to challenge four wide leaving the far turn, resisted the winner's bid to late stages but proved only second best. MR NUM NUM, reserved saving ground tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve position while edging a rival for a share. JANUARY BEE was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the backstretch, continued to duel with that foe into the far turn but gave way nearing midstretch. JUSTHEGUYTODOIT tracked the leaders in second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, shifted out three deep but steadily faded leaving the far turn. BIG SMOOTH was settled near the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch and made an effort to pass some tiring rivals. SIX GUN ROYAL was urged to join the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue through the far turn and gave way. WILD COMMAND tracked the leaders between foes off the second flight in the opening half but offered no closing bid. SAILING ALONG bobbled at the start, settled into stride and never menaced thereafter.
