Footnotes

BREEZY POINT took up a position off and outside the second flight unhurried in the opening stages, steadily moved to striking position while shifting out four wide racing into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command and forge clear late under pressure. BATITO settled between foes in the opening quarter, angled seven wide racing through the stretch and made steady late progress to prevail for second. DANDYMAN broke outwards bumping, was settled in last off the inside racing to the turn, angled out eight wide in upper stretch and displayed some late interest while missing for second. GARLAND'S SPIRIT tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, moved to challenge three deep between foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. I'M INCLUDED tracked off the second flight between foes, split rivals briefly gaining some position racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. CAN'T STOP RAVIN joined the pace outside a rival from the outset, gained brief command racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. AIKMAN tracked the pace outside foes, made brief progress four wide between racing into the stretch but proved empty late.

AUGUST DAY tracked off the second flight near the inside racing into the turn but offered no closing bid. CLOUT settled along the inside early and never seriously menaced. HOTROD STICK, caught five deep racing into the turn, never gained contention. A'INTYOU DREAMIN briefly disputed the pace inside a rival racing into the turn but was through after a half. ROYAL JAKE tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight and steadily faded racing into the stretch.
