**Footnotes**

CAMPO JOTI broke outwards, was righted to gain a position just off the leaders along the inside racing to the bend, shifted out three wide nearing upper stretch to challenge, took over leaving the furlong marker and drew away under firm handling. HONOUR FIRST broke readily, angled inwards attending a rival's pace racing to the turn, pressed the issue nearing upper stretch to gain a narrow advantage but proved no match when confronted by the winner. CROSSWISE hopped at the start, settled into stride in late, swung seven wide entering upper stretch and found her best stride late to earn a share. INDIAN CHARLIZE broke sharply, was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the turn, dueled for command to midstretch and weakened late. EVERYBODY LIES tracked the leaders along the inside from just out of striking distance, saved ground to upper stretch and finished evenly. NEED MORE LUCK, held up out of tight quarters at the start, tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the bend, swung six wide racing into upper stretch while gaining some position but had no final response. JUDY MY DARLING, reserved outside foes in the opening stages, never gained striking distance. CHEESE A BAY, brushed by TAP DAZZLER and held up in tight quarters at the start, tracked between foes off the second flight racing to the turn but lacked a closing response. I DON'T THINK SO tracked the leaders between foes as part of the second flight racing to the bend but dropped out early. TAP DAZZLER shied outwards at the start brushing a rival, was righted to briefly contend three deep racing to the turn as part of the second flight but soon gave way.
