STAKES Hawthorne Gold Cup H. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

A HANDICAP FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$2,500 to pass the entry box, \$2,500 additional to start. With \$500,000 Guaranteed, of which 60 percent to the winner, 20 percent to second, 11 percent to third, 6 percent to fourth, 3 percent to fifth. NOTE: This stake will be limited to fourteen starters. High weights (including scale of weights and sex allowance) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights and second weighted parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. Failure to draw into race will cancel all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations closed Saturday, September 23, 2000 with 20.

DUST ON THE BOTTLE was allowed to settle inside while the rear of the field, came around a tiring rival on the final turn, went back to the rail for the drive and gained determinedly while kept to urging. GUIDED TOUR raced close up while three wide, was asked to go after GOLDEN MISSILE in the stretch then bested that one for the place while unable to go with the winner. GOLDEN MISSILE stalked the pace from just outside, took over the lead on the second turn and responded in the drive but could not last. PUERTO MADERO (CHI) was void of speed, angled widest for the drive then gained ground but was too late. BLAZING SWORD lacked speed off the rail and was never a factor. CATIENUS settled in between horses, made a run on the second turn and faltered. MULA GULA checked when he ran up on horses on the first turn and saved ground but tired. EL BALLEZANO was fractious in the paddock, set the pace on a clear lead, tired and was eased.
