DISTORTED GROOM set a contested pace, held well into the stretch and dug in determinedly to prevail. RAPID JACK raced in striking position while five wide, remained five wide into the stretch, rallied willingly but missed. ERDISTON settled well, entered the stretch four wide and stayed on. NEVILL'S MISTAKE prompted the pace and weakened. PROFESSOR HENNESSY was hesitant at the start and displayed mild late interest. COWBOY SHOES leaned in at the start and had no rally. W W CASE ACE never menaced. STORM BOOT LARRY brushed at the start, chased the pace and dropped back in the stretch. EDGERRIN showed little.
