**Footnotes**

JILL made steady progress to gain position just off the second flight in the opening stages, angled to the rail nearing the bend while moving into contention, shifted out to challenge three deep between foes in upper stretch, then wrested command and edged clear late in the final stages under steady handling. EXPLOSIVE DART, a bit slow into stride, saved ground on the bend, shifted out five wide racing through the stretch and found her best stride late to secure the place. ENTY'S GIRL, bumped, then carried out into the path of LA PANCHITA at the start, was quickly righted, then urged to the lead along the inside, held sway past midstretch but failed to sustain her momentum. PECOSA was urged to secure a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter, pressed that foe on the turn, but gave way near midstretch. I'MA ROCKIN BULL tracked outside foes off the second flight in the opening stages and continued evenly racing four deep into the stretch. SHARP DAY broke outwards bumping ENTY'S GIRL forcing her into a rival's path, was held up from just out of striking distance tracking the leaders a bit off the inside, shifted out to lodge a brief, four wide bid nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the last furlong. LA PANCHITA, bumped and forced out at the start, passed outside some tiring rivals racing into the stretch. BELLAMY LASS tracked off the second flight along the inside racing into the bend but came up empty nearing upper stretch. OKIE GIRL tracked the pace outside foes as part of the second flight early, was caught four wide racing through the turn and steadily faded from contention. FAT'S GRAY GIRL tracked the leaders near the inside from well out of striking position early and never mounted a serious challenge. MISS CALLAWAY was a bit outpaced racing five deep in the opening stages and soon dropped out.
