Footnotes

SPANISH ROYALTY, urged to secure the lead from between foes in the opening furlong, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the turn and held sway to the end under steady pressure. SHARE THE JOY tracked the leaders outside foes just off the second flight racing to the bend, then continued with a steady three wide bid to prove best of the others. COUNTRY CAUCUS tracked the pacesetter between foes in second flight racing to the turn and couldn't produce the needed closing response. POSH LADY, urged to a forward placing along the inside early, tracked the leader along the rail into the bend and continued evenly to the stretch. MIDNIGHT KUGER was settled out of striking distance along the inside early but never gained contention. CAP'N SWIFTER never seriously menaced. REAL OBVIOUS tracked the leaders off the second flight while four wide early and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. JOHN D'S VALENTINE, urged to a forward placing three deep in the opening stages, retreated from contention early. DUE TO A TELETIMER MALFUNCTION, THE RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
