Footnotes

WINDY CITY LEAL, within striking distance outside foes from the outset, moved to force the issue three deep racing into the turn, edged clear entering upper stretch and held MARITIME MAN safe to the end under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, reserved tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance outside a rival in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention on his own courage nearing upper stretch, angled five wide entering the lane and continued with a steady effort to close the gap while only second best. FOXY ON SUNDAY, held up just off the leaders stalking the pace racing to the bend, shifted four wide to bid between foes entering upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the top pair but edged a rival for a share. SPREAD THE CHIPS was urged to dispute the pace along the inside from the outset, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. POSH'S FAIRY TALE required a shoe repair in the paddock, was urged to force the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, dueled for command between foes on the turn into upper stretch and gave way. HIP HOPPER broke a bit awkwardly, settled into stride, shifted outside foes racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. AWESOME LIMBO broke slowly and never gained striking distance. RAMBUNCTIOUS SPY was soon outpaced racing along the inside. ELUSIVE CLIMBER settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained striking distance. TRICKY GOLIARD was urged along racing just out of

striking distance near the inside early but steadily retreated. THE CRAFTY NICKLE ducked out at the start and soon trailed.
